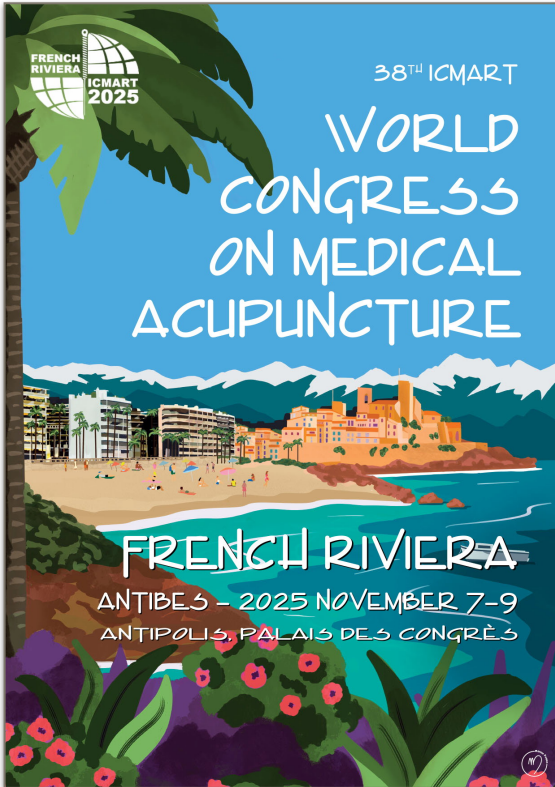




March 2025

DO YOU WANT TO KNOW MORE ABOUT JAPANESE ACUPUNCTURE ?

Traditional Japanese Medicine (TJM)

has experienced two major events:

- the introduction of Chinese Acupuncture and Moxibustion *via* Korea and then directly from China around the 6th-7th century.
- then the upheaval brought by European medicine since the end of the 16th century, at the beginning of trade with Europe.

Among the consequences of this opening to the Western world, an imperial edict of 1884 prohibited the teaching of TJM. But its effectiveness confirmed by patients and the resistance to the use of European medicine enabled its survival.



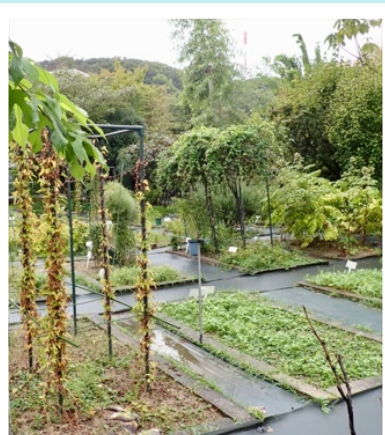
Japanese have adapted their practices to modern obligations:

asepsis, absence of heavy metals.

Professor Keiko Ogawa

and her team within the Department of Traditional Medicine at Hiroshima University will allow us to measure and compare the specificities of TJM in relation to those of TCM : modern herbal medicine, superficial acupuncture, different from that used in China and in Western countries.

As you will discover by participating in the symposium they will organize during our Congress in Antibes,, the diagnosis is based on taking the radial pulses, after questioning, examining the tongue and, essentially the patient's reaction to abdominal palpation. Puncture is delicate, millimetric, subcutaneous and slow acupuncture, even sessile *deqi* or flicks on the needle sleeve. Moxibustion is also noticeably different.



Traditional herbal medicine.
