Here are the practical information concerning your presentation

For oral presentations: the presentation duration is 10 to 12 minutes, followed by a 3-minute question and answer session. However, only some oral presentations may last up to 25 minutes, followed by a 3-minute question and answer session, if this is expressly mentioned in the presentation schedule communicated in this document.

For workshops: each session lasts 45 minutes. Some workshops last two sessions if this is expressly specified in the presentation schedule communicated in this document.

For symposia: the length and order of presentations included in the symposium may vary depending on the organization communicated by each symposium chair. However, the total time allocated to each symposium will not exceed 90 minutes.

For posters: posters must be displayed starting Friday morning at 8:30 AM and removed Sunday at 12:00 PM.

At least one poster author must be present at the Saturday poster session, from 4:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m., to answer any questions from interested audiences.

For all oral presentations, workshops, and symposia, please find attached a presentation template. We ask you to use it as a support document for your presentation to facilitate the organization of the conference. Please also save your presentation file in PPTX and PDF formats.

If you want to have your presentation published in the proceedings of the Congress, any associated text, also saved in PDF format, must be sent to abstract@icmart2025.org before October 15, 2025.
